

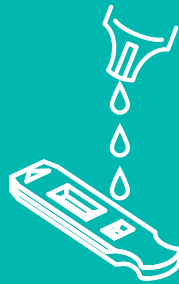
Testing Works

COVID-19 vaccinations and testing



The major vaccines **will not** affect the results¹ of SARS-CoV-2 tests on the BD MAX™ and BD Veritor™ Plus Systems

The vaccine **will not** trigger a positive test result



A positive or negative test result is **independent** of vaccination status

BD MAX™ and BD Veritor™ Plus System tests **do not** detect the part of the vaccine that creates immunity (mRNA or spike protein)



Testing should continue to be used to **detect infections** and **protect the community** from the SARS-CoV-2 virus²

Based on BD analysis of vaccines currently authorized for use or in development (Pfizer-BioNTech; Moderna; Astra-Zeneca/Oxford; J&J).
